We have fun!!!!



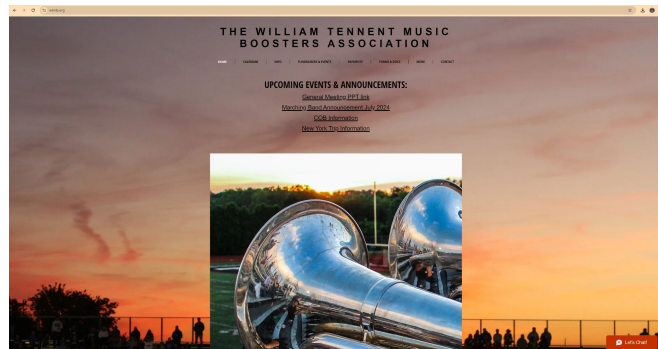

Jazz will meet Tuesday and Thursday from 3:00-5:00 starting after the winter concert (December 17 and 19).

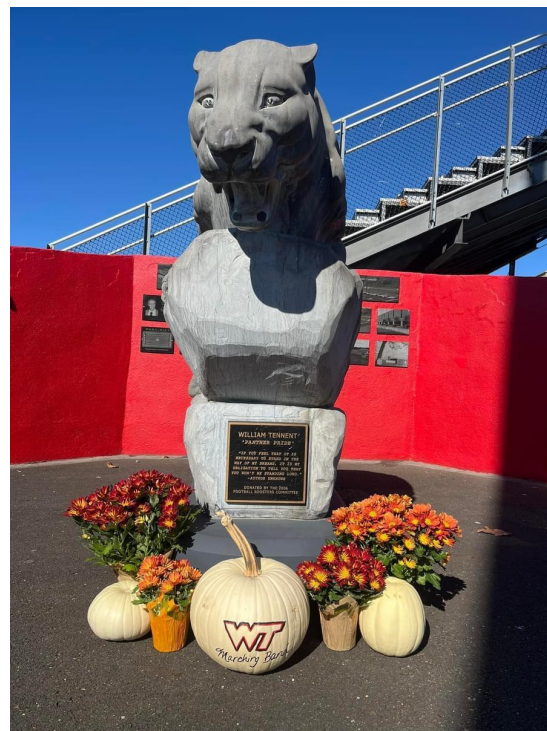
Jazz will be on a regular Tuesday/Thursday schedule starting January 7 (First Tuesday back from break).
